

Traditional Project Management software was designed around Waterfall. Every step is planned in advance. Example: delivering cars with working breaks.

Agile in a nutshell: people over processes, ship early, don't trust customers to know what they want, refine & improve.

Examples:

- Monthly newspaper
- Onboarding process in a company
- Spotify app on your phone

- Cumulative Flow Diagram
- Average Age Report
- Created vs. Resolved Issues Report
