**Strategy: Vision**, Goals, and Value delivery through Objective Key Results

**Answers to: WHAT and WHY** 

**Tactics:** Deliverables, specific actions to achieve objectives (OKR), measurable through Key Performance Indicators (KPI)

**Answers to: HOW** 

(OKR)

#### **Bridging the Two**

• Bridging strategy and tactics is **making sure your actions are** aligned with your vision and goals.

#### Why It Matters:

If there's no bridge between strategy and tactics, the organization might waste time and resources on things that don't actually help reach its big goals. Digital transformation acts as the bridge that allows organizations to scale effectively by aligning their long-term strategy with actionable tactics therefore solving some of the key organizational challenges.



### Key organizational challenges

#### **Question #2**

What are some of the key organizational challenges?

**Key challenges** in organizational transformation often include:

- · Vision is missing.
- **Scaling efficiently** without sacrificing quality.
- **Ensuring transparency** fostering clarity and trust.
- Aligning roles and teams to drive cohesive efforts.
- Managing dependencies to avoid bottlenecks and delays.
- Making informed decisions based on factual data.
- Navigating terminology confusion that leads to miscommunication.

These challenges can slow the progress but its crucial address them for a successful transformation and Jira Align is a tool that can support you.

- Jira Align is an Enterprise Agile Planning Software that helps large organizations plan, track, and manage agile work, aligning strategy with execution.
- Data-Driven Decisions: Provides leaders with a clear, data-backed view of progress for informed decision-making.
- Connects Strategy to Delivery: Links dynamic strategies with deliverables, enabling quick adaptation.
- **Centralized Platform**: Serves as a single source of truth for all work across the organization.
- **Capacity Insights**: Offers visibility into team capacity, helping predict deliverables and allocate resources effectively.
- **Scaling Agile**: Supports scaling agile across teams and portfolios with built-in framework support.
- Managing OKRs: Aligns work with OKRs at all levels, reducing manual reporting and improving planning.

- **Jira** is focused more on deliverables, day-to-day activities and it's used by development teams.



Why use Jira Align?

If you have asked yourself one of these questions, then Jira Align might be for you:

- Why are we developing certain features, and how do they impact our customers?
- Can we manage expectations during Program Increment (PI) by aligning teams with priorities?
- Do we have enough capacity at the Program/Solution/Portfolio level to meet our priorities?
- Do we have full insight into our team's dependencies?
- Are we tracking cycle time, blocked items, and mitigation plans effectively?
- Are you tired of sharing progress in multiple formats for different stakeholders?
- What's the overall progress on key items that support the business?
- Why is it so difficult to consolidate plans for a full view of products/platforms?
- Can you see all work happening across the enterprise?
- Do leaders want to see how all teams' work connects to strategy and vision?

### **Best practices**

**Best Practices** 

Jira Align works if the organization is mature in working agile.

Jira Align should not be used without Jira.

Customize, But Don't Overdo It.

Atlassian recommends to use JA when you have more than 500 users.

Since Jira Align is not a BI solution, pair it with a dedicated app: Atlassian Analytics, PowerBI, Tableau, etc.

Establish Governance and Roles.

Pricing - Starting from ~80k \$, therefore R&R must be well defined. https://www.atlassian.com/software/jira/align/pricing
